"... When I paint the willow tree on an island in The Thames near Cookham, I cannot help thinking of what Stanley Spencer said, "You can't walk by the river at Cliveden Reach and not believe in God", with which I can completely identify and empathise, even if I have no belief in a divine being. Cezanne said very similar things. But I also hold with the Zen notion of essence, as in the story of child and parent looking into a meadow. The child asks, "Is that a horse?" to which the parent replies, "No, that is just what we call it." I think pictorial construction (to put it drily) has always been wary of over conceptualisation, when we often give precedence to the literary over the visual..."
